**Title of the special issue:** *New Generation of Applied Linguists in Europe*

**Context:**

At the AILA Europe Junior Researchers Meeting 2019 in Sarajevo, the Junior Researchers expressed their wish for support in publishing their research. AILA Europe and EuJAL are responding to this request by publishing a Special Issue that provides insights into the work of the new generation of applied linguists in Europe. The Special Issue will feature contributions from researchers who have presented their work at the last three Junior Researchers Meetings: Sarajevo 2019, Groningen 2021, and Toulouse 2021.

**Submission:**

The submission process consists of two steps:

**First submission by January 21, 2022:**

- Junior researchers presenting in one of the three previous AILA Junior Researcher Meetings can submit a full paper here: <http://jrm2022.sciencesconf.org/>
- Papers can be submitted in two formats:
  - Short paper (3-4 pages): overview paper presenting ongoing research.
  - Full paper (15 pages): presenting original and unpublished research.
- Authors must follow the EuJAL requirements for submissions (<https://www.degruyter.com/journal/key/eujal/html>) and use the style sheet (click here).
- Requirements for both formats: Authors must give clear information about 1) the theoretical and/or experimental framework, 2) the methodological setup, 3) data analysis.
- The submissions will be reviewed by guest editors by February 15, 2022

**Second submission in February 2022**

- February 2022: Authors whose papers were accepted by guest editors submit individually on EuJAL manuscript website: <http://mc.manuscriptcentral.com/eujal>
- March 2022 Double-blind review by EuJAL reviewers
- April 2022: Authors receive revised papers
- June 2022: Submission of the final version by the authors
- July 2022: Final proofreading by authors
- September 2022: Publication.
